The clinics will be held in the morning, the first event on our program at 10.00am.

This is a huge opportunity to gain a lot of skills and knowledge from elite athletes and we believe that it would be an immense benefit to students who participate.

We have secured two high profile athletes , with their highly respected coach Scott Rowsell.

Maddie Coates is a 20 year old who ran 2nd in the 200m Australian Championships this year.

She represented Australia at the Commonwealth Games in the 200m & 4 x 100m relay.

In 2017 Maddie was Victorian Champion in the 100m & 200m also in 2016 was in the top eight Under 20 in the world rankings for the 200m.

Jacob Despard is 22 years of age he was the Stawell Gift Winner 2018.

He can run 100m in 10.6 seconds and 200m in 21.6 seconds.

Scott Rowsell is their highly respected Coach who has won AACC Coach of the year in 2013/2014.

He has coached:

1 x Commonwealth Games Semi Finalist

1 x Stawell Gift Winner

3 x Juniors have competed in the World Championships
